- SEAC officially opens at 7am on Saturday 30th June and closes 10pm on Monday 2nd July
- Ingleside Scout Camp will close at midday on Tuesday the 3rd of July
- Early bird applications close on the 30th April with final applications to be in by 31st May.

- An information handbook will be available for Adults and Youth when they register at the campsite.
- All applicants 18 years and over must sign and attach a Prohibited Employment Declaration form
